Per the McKean County Municipal Waste Flow Control Ordinance, regulating the disposal of municipal waste in McKean County, it is stated that the material described below must be disposed of at the McKean County Landfill:

Section II

“Construction/Demolition Waste -- A portion of regulated Municipal Waste, as defined herein, resulting from the construction or demolition of buildings and other structures, including wood, plaster, drywall and wall board, metals, asphaltic substances, bricks, block and unsegregated concrete. The term also includes dredging waste, grubbing waste and street sweepings. The term does not include the following if they are separate from other waste and used as clean fill:

- (1) Uncontaminated soil, rock, stone, gravel, unused brick and block and concrete.
- (2) Waste from land clearing, grubbing and excavation including trees, brush, stumps and vegetative material.”
