

BOROUGH OF KANE

APPLICATION FOR CONVAISSING AND SOLICITING

No person shall engage in the sale of merchandise or canvassing and soliciting in the Borough of Kane without first having registered with the Borough of Kane and obtain an Identification Card from the Borough Manager.

Upon completion of the application, the Chief of Police will conduct a criminal history check on the applicant within ten (10) working days. No application card will be issued to any person who has been convicted of a felony or misdemeanor.

An Identification Card will be valid for the calendar year in which it is issued. Such card may not be transferred from one person to another.

Standard of Conduct:

Every person to whom an Identification Card has been issued shall, in the conduct of his or her activities, comply with the following standards of conduct:

- He or she shall carry their Identification Card at all times and exhibit it upon request to any police officer or to any person on whom he or she shall call or talk.
- He or she shall not permit any person to have possession of his Identification Card and shall immediately report its loss to the Kane Borough Manager. He or she shall not cause or permit this Identification Card to be altered or defaced in any way.
- He or she shall not enter or attempt to enter any dwelling without the invitation or permission of the occupant and shall immediately leave any premise upon request of the occupant.
- He or she shall not engage in the sale of merchandise or in canvassing and soliciting after dark.
- He or she shall not represent this Identification Card as an endorsement of him or herself, the goods and services of his or her employer.
- He or she shall immediately surrender this Identification Card to the Borough Manager or any police officer upon revocation thereof.
- Any Identification Card may be revoked by the Borough Manager if the holder fails to comply with the standards of conduct or upon ascertainment by the Police Department that the holder had made a false statement in his or her application.

Fees:

Upon completion of the application and the criminal background check, the Borough Manager is authorized to issue a license upon receipt of payment, either in person or by mail, of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).

APPLICATION FOR CANVASSING AND SOLICITING

- Before any person shall engage in the sale of merchandise or canvassing and soliciting in the Borough of Kane the following application must be completed.
- Upon completion of this application, the Chief of Police or Borough Manager shall issue an Identification Card within ten (10) working days, provided that the applicant has not been convicted of a felony or misdemeanor.
- Upon issuance of the Identification Card, a payment of fifty dollars (\$50.00) must be made to the Borough of Kane by the applicant.
- If the Identification Card is revoked by either the Borough Manager or any Police Officer, there shall be NO refunds of the fee.
